

„3W” Special Prize for ł.pitch Startup Competition 2022 Finalists Terms and Conditions

By submitting your application to the ł.pitch Startup Competition 2022, you agree to the following terms and conditions and to be considered for the “3W” Special Prize:

General Rules

1. All the information supplied to us in your application and presentation is true and accurate to the best of your knowledge.
2. The term ‘information supplied’ refers to your startup or company.
3. ł.pitch Startup Competition is organised by the LSE SU Polish Business Society.
4. By entering the ł.pitch Startup Competition you agree to act in good faith, with integrity and respect throughout the whole duration of the ł.pitch Startup Competition and the 2022 Polish Economic Forum.
5. By applying to ł.pitch Startup Competition 2022 you agree to be considered to be awarded the “3W” Special Prize.
6. The „3W” Special Prize for ł.pitch Startup Competition 2022 Finalists is provided by Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego.
7. The Special Prize Terms and Conditions apply to discretionary prize that Bank Gospodarstwa Krajowego issues to recognised ł.pitch Startup Competition’s Finalist.
8. In the event of no applicants meet the requirements to be awarded the “3W” Special Prize, the organisers reserve the right to withhold the presentation of the “3W” Special Prize.

Eligibility:

1. „3W” Special Prize is aimed at startups developing ideas in the area of water, hydrogen, and/or carbon modern technologies. Every project applying to ł.pitch that implements technologies based on water, hydrogen, and/or carbon is eligible to be considered for the award.
2. Entry is only open to startups that apply to ł.pitch Startup Competition 2022, i.e., are based in Poland or in which at least one of the co-founders is a Polish citizen.
3. Only startups in the pre-seed and seed funding stage are eligible to apply.

ł.pitch Startup Competition:

1. All applicants must fill out the 1.pitch Startup Competition application form to be eligible to be considered for the “3W” Special Award.
2. You agree that the information shared as part of the application process will be accessible and processed by the administrators, judges, and sponsors within the purpose of organising the contest.
3. The contest will consist of a closed preselection process and a final taking place during the 2022 Polish Economic Forum on March 12th, 2022.

Final:

1. Four teams will be selected to participate in the final stage of the 1.pitch Startup Competition. The final stage of 1.pitch will take place in London at the 2022 Polish Economic Forum on March 12th, 2022. It is mandatory to attend and present your idea at this event to be considered for the “3W” Special Prize.
2. The “3W” Special Prize will be awarded based on the pitch delivered during the 1.pitch Startup Competition panel.
3. During your presentation you will be assessed by the panel of the 1.pitch Startup Competition jurors and the board assessing eligibility to be awarded the “3W” Special Prize. The jury at their own discretion will choose the winners and award any prizes.
4. Should any prizes be awarded by individual jury members it is compulsory that you consent to any terms and conditions before receiving the prize.

Miscellaneous:

1. All information and data provided by participants when they enter the competition will be held and used by the LSE SU Polish Business Society and their partners to administer the competition.
2. Each team maintains all rights, title, and interest in and to its respective intellectual property.
3. Administrators reserve the right to extend the application deadlines, adjust or revise the eligibility of startups, evaluation criteria, or methodology in their sole discretion, as found necessary. The sole and exclusive recourse any applicant shall have to such changes is to withdraw their application from 1.pitch Startup Competition.
4. By agreeing to participate in the contest you agree that any content produced on site of the contest, such as photos, video material, and quotes, may be used by the LSE SU Polish

Business Society as well as any other media organisations to further promote activities of the LSE SU Polish Business Society and the Polish Economic Forum.

5. The LSE SU Polish Business Society cannot reimburse any costs incurred by the participants including those related to the travel to any venue that the contest may take place at.
